11 page, I saw a link near the top titled: "Candidates on the Ballot." Upon clicking that link, I  
12 was sent to Exhibit 1.

13 3. Returning to the web page which had sent me to Exhibit 1, I saw a link that  
14 read: "Use Your Voter Guide to create a custom sample ballot." Attached as Exhibit 2 is a  
15 true and correct copy of the custom sample ballot displayed to me by King County Elections  
16 after I provided my name and address. I have redacted my home address from the exhibit.

17 4. Attached as Exhibit 3 is a true and correct copy of the General Election Online  
18 Voter's Guide provided to me by the Secretary of State's website when I clicked on a bold-  
19 faced link entitled "2010 General Election Voter's Guide" on the Secretary of State's  
20 "Elections and Voting" webpage (<http://www.sos.wa.gov/elections/>). Exhibit 3 is the result of  
21 clicking "Expand All" and scrolling past the State Measures to the Federal and Congressional  
22 candidates.

23 5. Attached as Exhibit 4 is a true and correct copy of the personalized voter guide  
24 that I received from the Secretary of State's website after clicking on the following icon found  
25 on the main "Elections and Voting" webpage:


