

Information Sheet for Washington State Penitentiary visit Oct 11, 2017

Directions:

Coming from the west on Highway 12, take the Myra Street exit. Turn right off the ramp to the second roundabout to the third turn, for Highway 125. This is Pine Street. At approximately ¼ mile, turn left onto 13th Avenue. After directional sign TO PRESCOTT.

Coming from the east on Highway 12, take the downtown exit. Turn right and then turn right again at the first street light. This is Pine Street. At approximately ½ mile turn right onto 13th Ave.

Coming from downtown, get on 2nd Avenue headed toward the highway. Turn left on Pine Street and turn right onto 13th Ave.

Further instructions after turning onto 13th Ave.

When you are on 13th Avenue, ahead you will see the prison on the hill to the left. Continue past any entrances to parking lots and past several brick houses behind white fences close to the road. The entrance is on the left. There is a 50 mph road sign approximately across from the entrance. You will see a small gate house on the left. It is not currently manned so continue through taking the road toward the low building in the distance. This is the public access building. You can come in the door on the left.

Important: Lock all valuables in the car, out of sight or in the trunk. Bring your state issued ID and car keys inside with you. You will be able to lock your keys in a small locker and will need your ID in order to get a visitor's pass. The locker key should be secured in a pocket while you are in the institution. You will pass through a security point and enter the restricted area to get a visitor's pass. Finally we enter the main facility, passing through three gates that are controlled by the main operations. The walk to the library takes about 5-8 minutes.
