WSL achieves these goals using federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) funds, offering numerous projects aimed at improving libraries, providing consulting services on a variety of topics, and providing grants, subsidies and training to libraries.

Libraries within this district have:

- 1. received \$47,325 as a result of Washington State Library Direct Grants and Subsidies during the past year; and
- 2. benefited from Statewide Programs and Services, which are not directly attributable to an individual library.
