- Volunteers are available to provide computer assistance

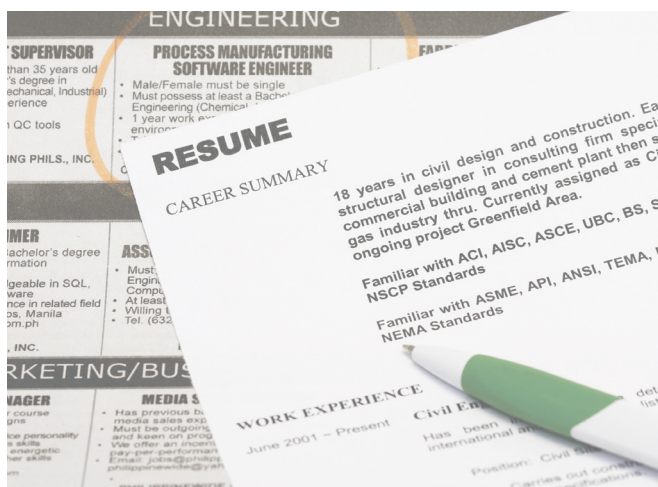
