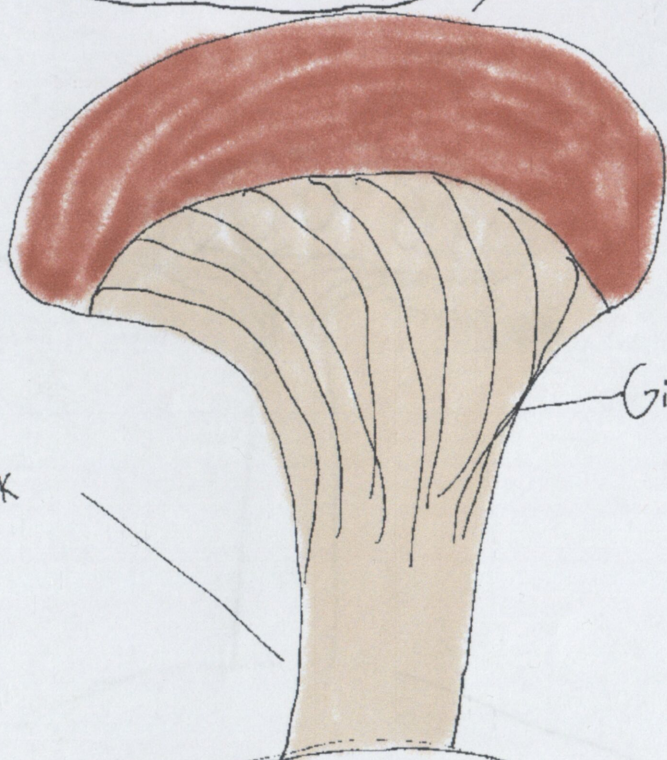

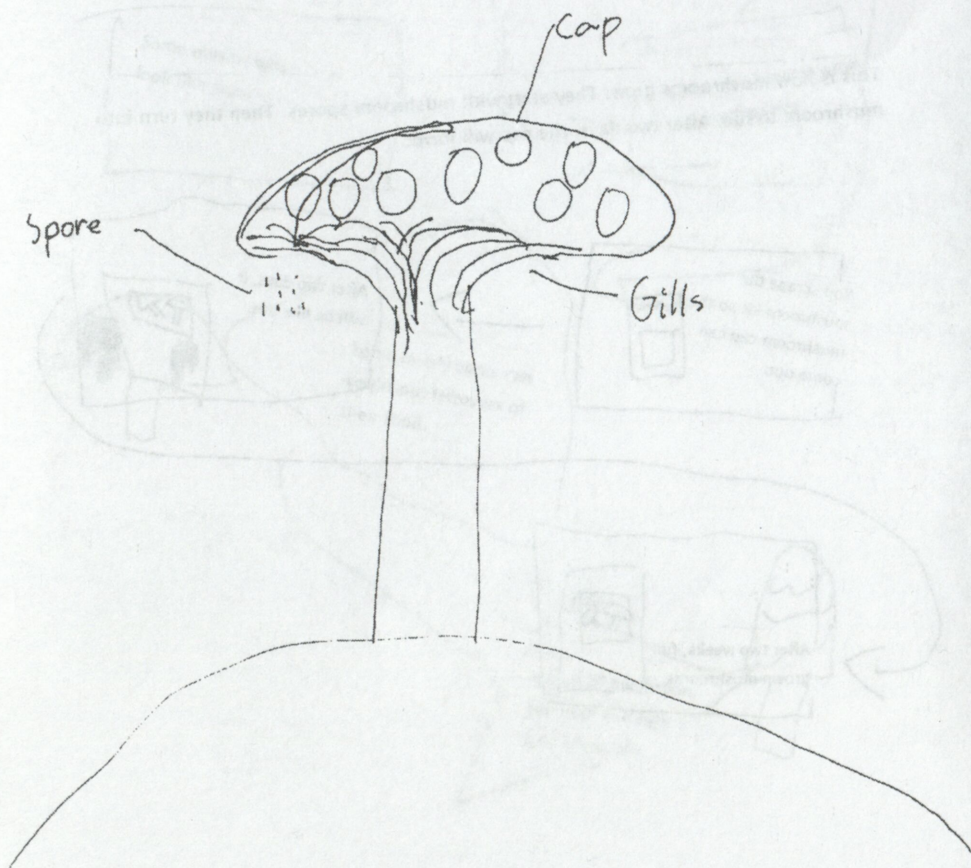

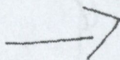
Mushrooms are not a kind of plants. They are fungi. They eat strips of wood and sugar water.

You scrape the mushroom kit so the mushroom cap can come out.



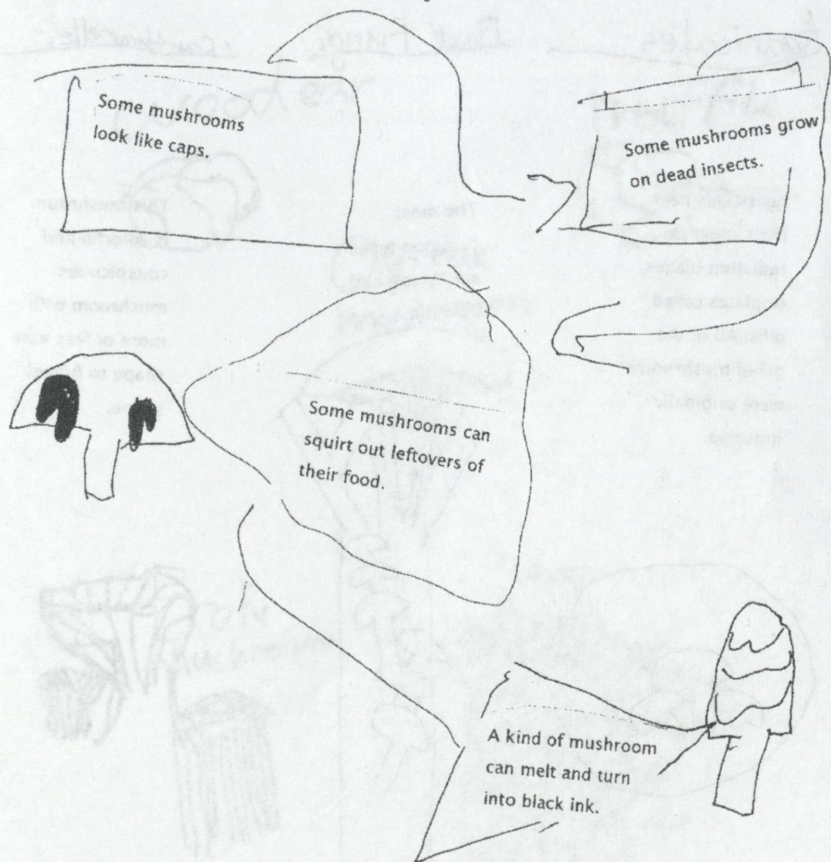
After two days, it will be like this.



After two weeks, full grown mushrooms.

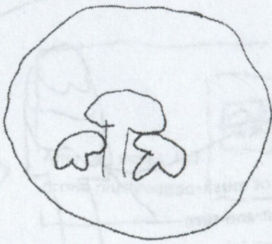

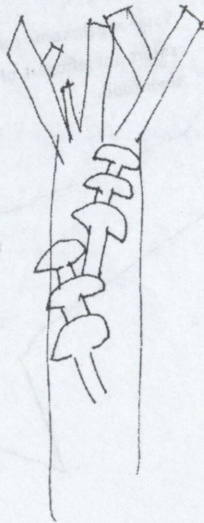
Agaricales

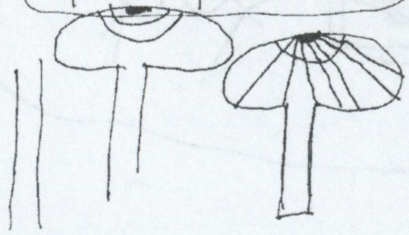
