
How To Pick Out The Right Cat At The Shelter & Take Care Of It.

6) Maybe the cat will come back and sleep




7) Maybe your cat will get hungry after the big road trip you did.

know each other and that they are not tussling too much.




11) Some people let their cats go free during the day.

19) Make sure your cat has a nice cozy bed.




