1 AN ACT Relating to designated providers occupying municipal-
2 controlled properties under the medical marijuana act; and amending RCW
3 69.51A.060.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 69.51A.060 and 2010 c 284 s 4 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (1) It shall be a misdemeanor to use or display medical marijuana
8 in a manner or place which is open to the view of the general public.

9 (2) Nothing in this chapter requires any health insurance provider
10 to be liable for any claim for reimbursement for the medical use of
11 marijuana.

12 (3) Nothing in this chapter requires any health care professional
13 to authorize the use of medical marijuana for a patient.

14 (4) Nothing in this chapter requires any accommodation of any on-
15 site medical use of marijuana in any place of employment, in any school
16 bus or on any school grounds, in any youth center, in any correctional
17 facility, or smoking medical marijuana in any public place as that term
18 is defined in RCW 70.160.020.

1 (5) Nothing in this chapter shall preclude a municipality, in the
2 interest of public safety and security through ordinance, from
3 requiring designated providers from occupying municipal-controlled
4 properties, for rent, _____
5 _____.

6 (6) It is a class C felony to fraudulently produce any record
7 purporting to be, or tamper with the content of any record for the
8 purpose of having it accepted as, valid documentation under RCW
9 69.51A.010(7)(a).

10 ((6)) (7) No person shall be entitled to claim the affirmative
11 defense provided in RCW 69.51A.040 for engaging in the medical use of
12 marijuana in a way that endangers the health or well-being of any
13 person through the use of a motorized vehicle on a street, road, or
14 highway.
