- 1 AN ACT Relating to qualifications for elective state office; and 2 adding a new section to chapter 29A.20 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 29A.20 RCW to read as follows:

Beginning with elections in 2006 and thereafter, every candidate 6 7 for elective state office in the state of Washington must pass the 8 tenth grade Washington assessment of student learning test before being 9 accepted by the secretary of state as an official candidate. Each 10 person filing for a state elective office must present to the office of 11 the secretary of state, at the time of filing officially for the 12 office, an affidavit certifying that the candidate has passed the tenth 13 grade Washington assessment of student learning test. The secretary of 14 state shall make arrangements with the superintendent of public 15 instruction to identify a location where the test will be administered 16 to prospective candidates. The superintendent of public instruction 17 will be responsible for preparing the affidavits. Each candidate must 18 pay the fee for administration of the test to himself or herself. 19 person may be accepted as an official candidate for state elective

- 1 office unless the prescribed affidavit accompanies his or her
- 2 application to the secretary of state.
