I, Sam Reed, Secretary of State of the State of Washington and custodian of its seal, hereby certify that, according to the records on file in my office, the attached copy of Initiative Measure No. 754 to the People is a true and correct copy as it was received by this office.

- 1 AN ACT Relating to codes; and creating a new section.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The presumption that codes are law shall be forever broken to free flesh and blood men and women from their created agencies' codes, policies, and ordinances.
- 6 It is the intent of the people to break the presumption that codes
- 7 are law, eliminating inappropriate taxation, enforcement, and
- 8 severability clauses, clarifying the true intent of the Washington
- 9 Constitution, Article I, section 1, 2, and 32, and severing and
- 10 exempting flesh and blood men and women from their created agencies'
- 11 codes, RCW, WAC, agency, municipality policies, and ordinances while
- 12 preserving the common law. The state of Washington, its subdivisions,
- 13 franchises, and instrumentalities shall be strictly limited to powers
- 14 granted in the original Washington state Constitution.
- The Revised Code of Washington, the Washington Administrative Code,
- 16 and all municipal ordinances are hereby repealed as applied to flesh
- 17 and blood people.
