I, Sam Reed, Secretary of State of the State of Washington and custodian of its seal, hereby certify that, according to the records on file in my office, the attached copy of Initiative Measure No. 783 to the People is a true and correct copy as it was received by this office.

An act relating to the preservation of the integrity of elections and our Constitutionally guaranteed form of government; adding a new section to chapter 42.17 RCW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 42.17 RCW to read as follows:

(1) No person may make contributions to a candidate, a candidate's authorized committee, or an election campaign if that person is not entitled to vote for said candidate or ballot proposition.

(2) No corporation or business entity may make contributions to a candidate, a candidate's authorized committee, or an election campaign.

(3) No person, corporation, business entity, political committee, or group of any kind shall use expenditures for political advertising in an election campaign unless such expenditures were derived from people who are entitled to vote in such an election.

(4) If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
