- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.08.040 and 1993 c 434 s 4 are each amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 The county auditor shall distribute forms by which a person may
- 8 register to vote by mail and cancel any previous registration in this
- 9 state. The registration form shall not require a person to pay
- 10 postage and shall bear the words "NO POSTAGE NECESSARY" in the upper
- 11 right hand corner of the side bearing the "OFFICIAL ELECTION MAIL"
- 12 <u>seal.</u> The county auditor shall keep a supply of voter registration
- 13 forms in his or her office at all times for political parties and
- 14 others interested in assisting in voter registration, and shall make
- 15 every effort to make these forms generally available to the public.

- 1 The county auditor shall provide voter registration forms to city and
- 2 town clerks, state offices, schools, fire stations, and any other
- 3 locations considered appropriate by the auditor for extending
- 4 registration opportunities to all areas of the county. After the
- 5 initial distribution of voter registration forms to a given location,
- 6 a representative designated by the official in charge of that
- 7 location shall notify the county auditor of the need for additional
- 8 voter registration supplies.

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
