- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 29A.20 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) Every candidate for state elective office in the state of Washington must pass the tenth-grade Washington assessment of student learning test before being accepted by the secretary of state as an official candidate. Each candidate filing for a state elective office must present an affidavit certifying that the candidate has passed the test to the office of the secretary of state, at the time of filing officially for the office.
 - (2) The secretary of state must make arrangements with the superintendent of public instruction to identify a location where the test will be administered to prospective candidates. Each candidate must pay the administration fee for the test.
- 17 (3) The superintendent of public instruction is responsible for 18 preparing the affidavits. No person shall be accepted as an official

- 1 candidate for state elective office unless the prescribed affidavit
- 2 accompanies his or her application to the secretary of state.
